

Fireplace Guide

1. You will find the gas controls at the bottom-right, when facing the fireplace.



2. Visually locate the Pilot, which can be found underneath the right side of the logs.

The Pilot is where you will be lighting, using the long safety lighter, in the next step.

3. Using the gas control dial, turn it counter-clockwise so the "PILOT" option is at 12 o'clock.

Holding your lighter flame on the Pilot, located in Step 2, push and hold the gas control dial inward, like a button. Gas will flow, and you should be able to light the Pilot.

Release the dial, then turn it to the "ON" position.

(Turn completely to "OFF" when you are done with the fireplace)



**Should the Pilot go out, the safety switch automatically turns off the flow of gas. Simply turn to "OFF" and restart the lighting process to re-light the fireplace.
